## DIWALI

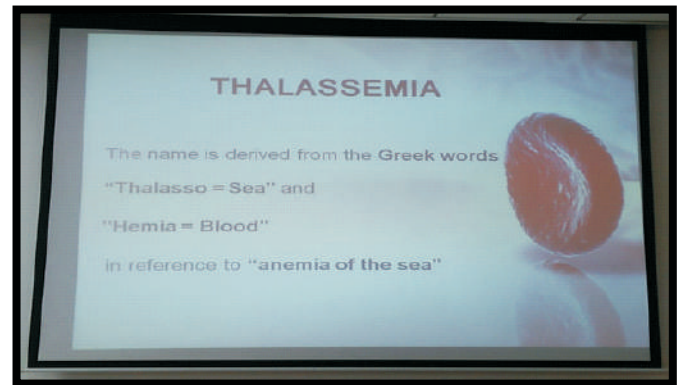
**“Let’s not forget our Nature this Diwali,

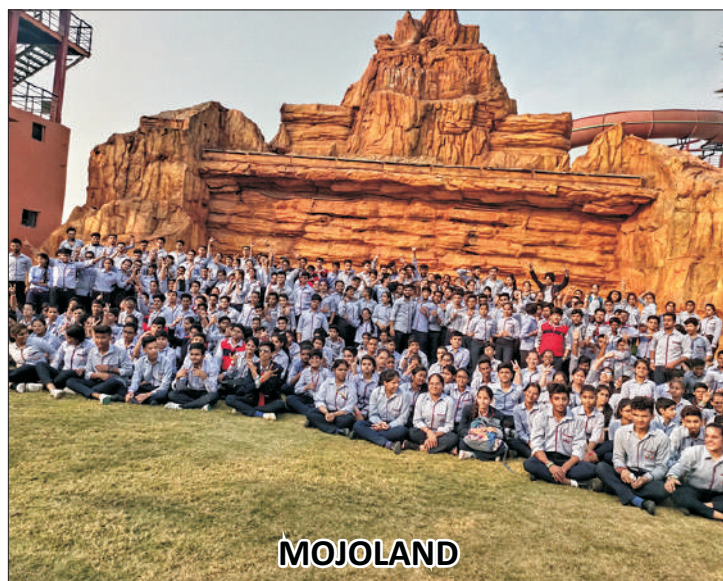
