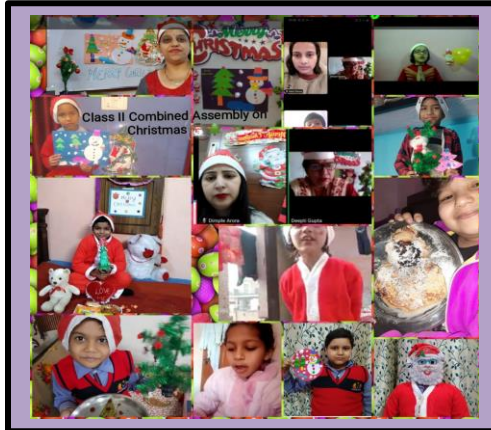

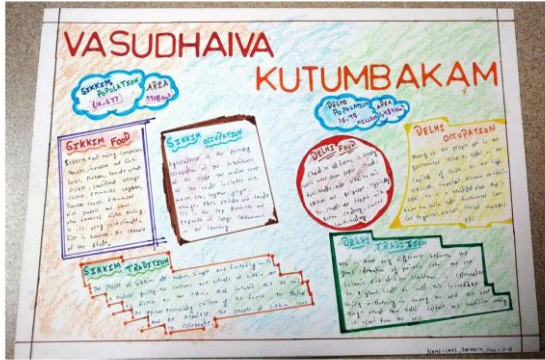

## Dussehra Celebration (25<sup>th</sup> Oct, 2020)

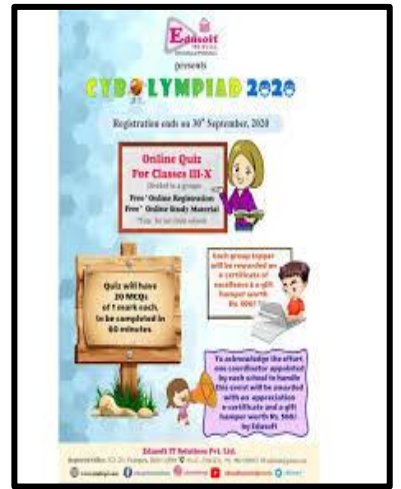
**Enjoy the Triumph of Truth over Evil....**

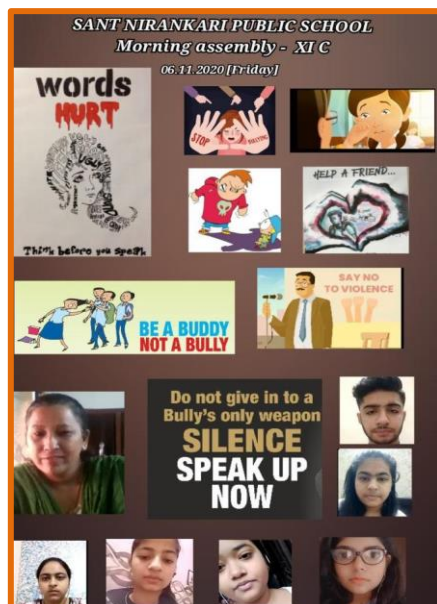

## 21st Nov, 2020

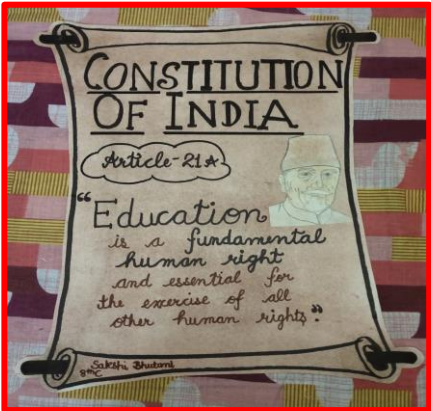
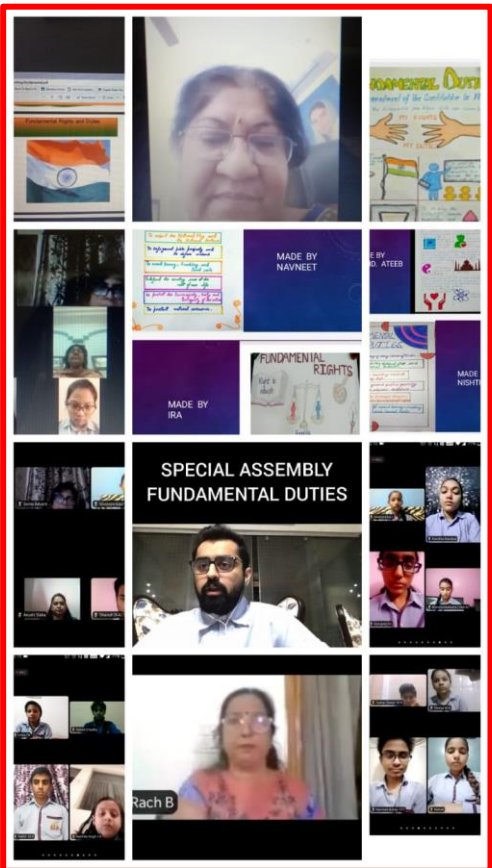
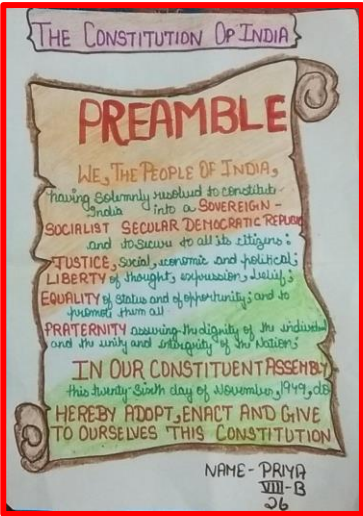

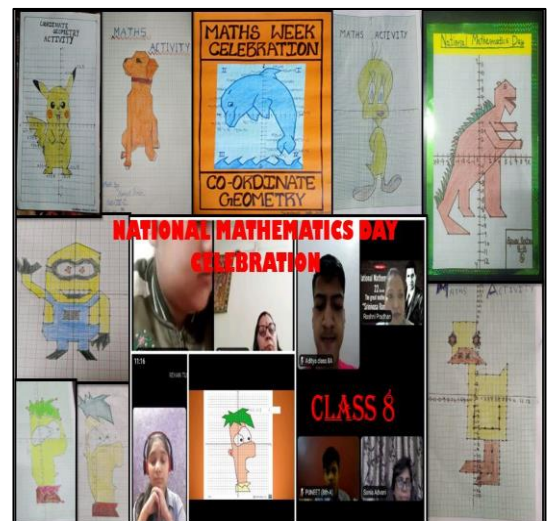
The best three entries were given Prizes from each class.

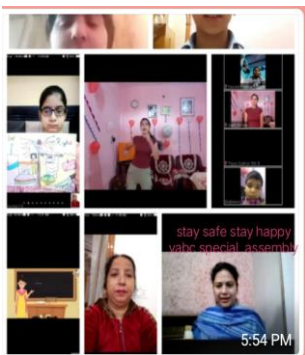
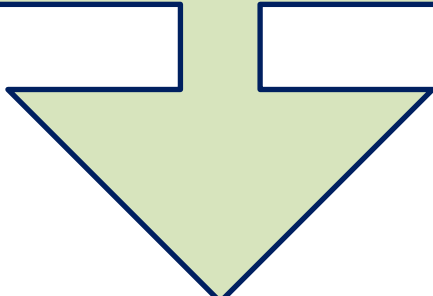
