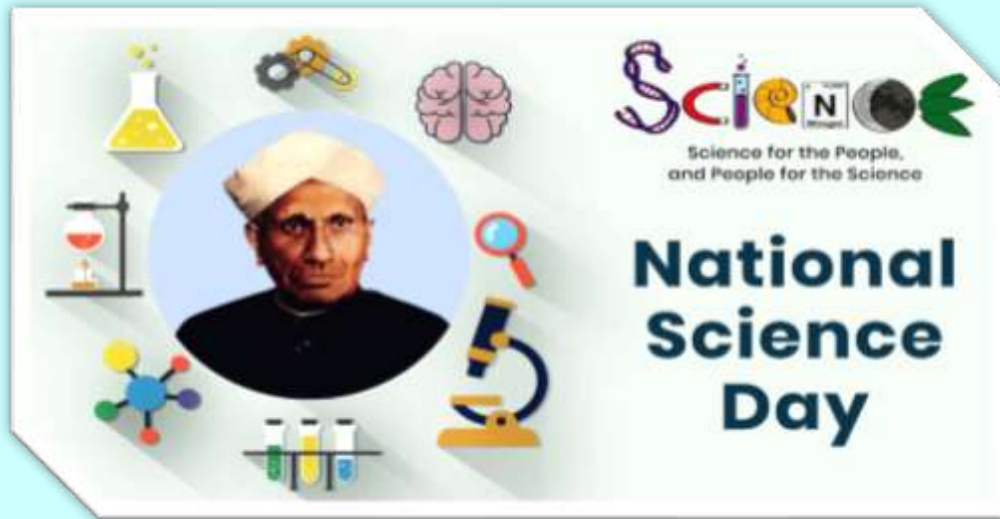

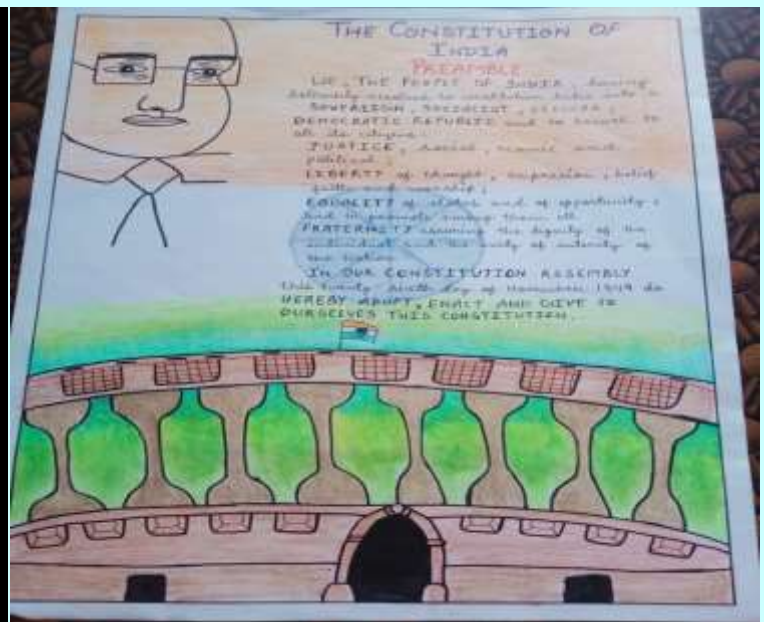


## ORIENTATION PROGRAMME FOR NEW SESSION
