Read the famous fairytale 'Cinderella'. After reading it, make beautiful puppets of any three characters from the story using ice cream sticks.



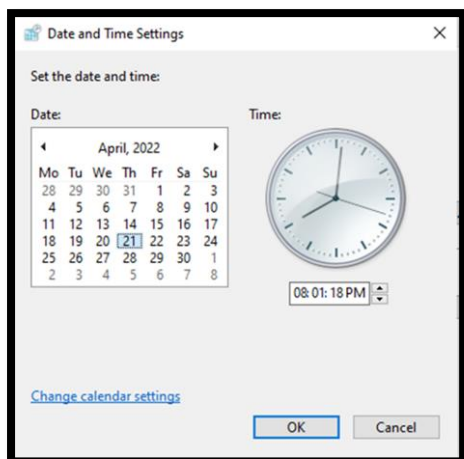
## 2. ART INTEGRATION LEARNING ACTIVITY-II

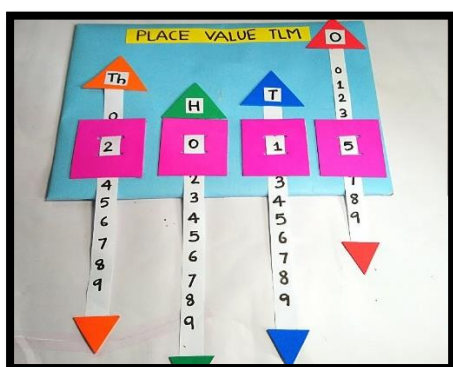

### SUBJECT: MATHS

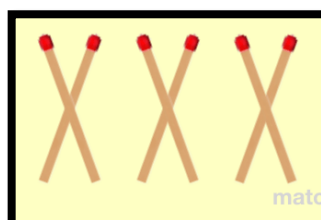
