‘A beautiful, bright and delighted day, sun entered makar to intense the ray. Crop harvested to cheer the smiles, come together and enjoy the life.’

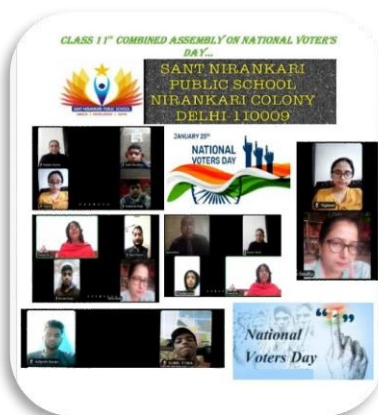

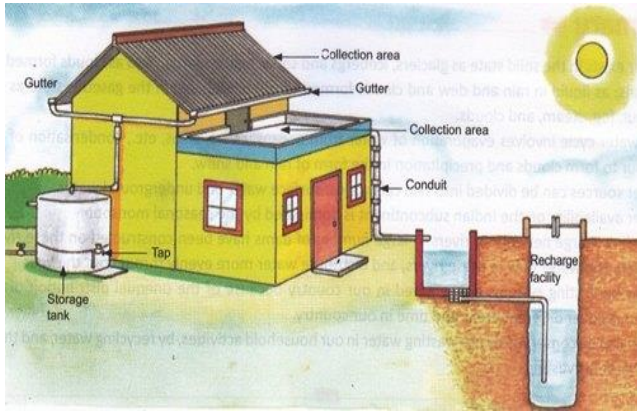


HERITAGE INDIA QUIZ (2021-22)

kids.

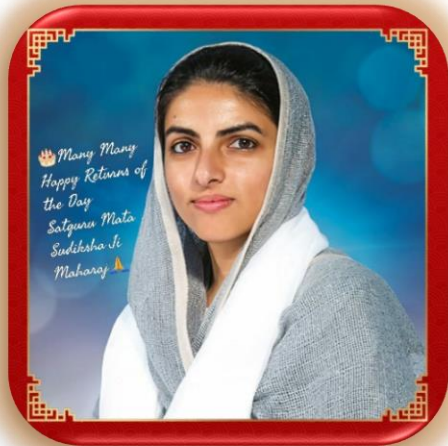


NIPUN BHARAT LAKSHAYA CAMPAIGN

The competition was witnessed by the HOS of the school along with the Coordinator and Hindi teachers of Primary Wing.

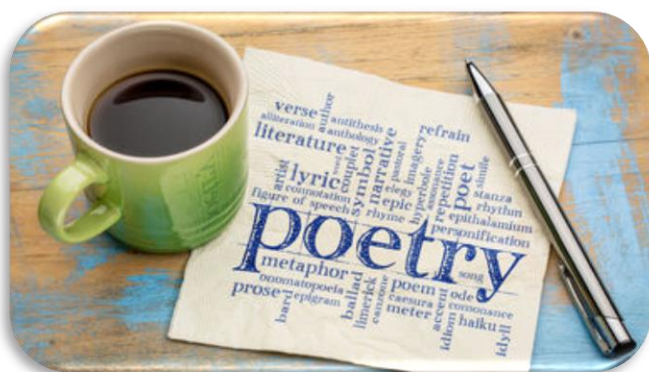

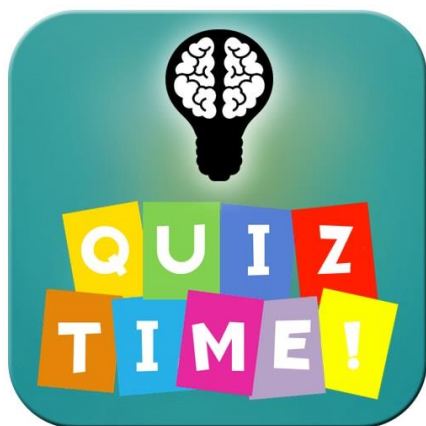
CBSE SCIENCE CHALLENGE (2021-22)

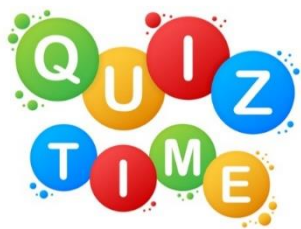

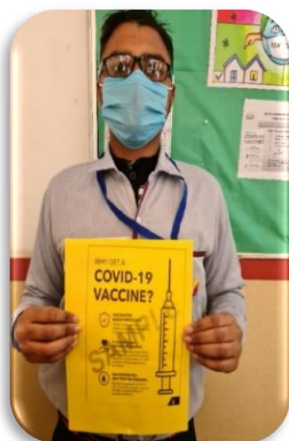
COVID VACCINATION DRIVE (15+ STUDENTS)

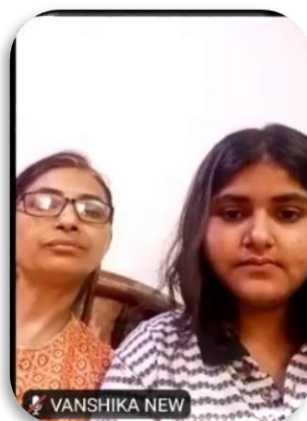
SENIOR WING ORIENTATION FOR CLASSES X & XII (SESSION 2022-23)

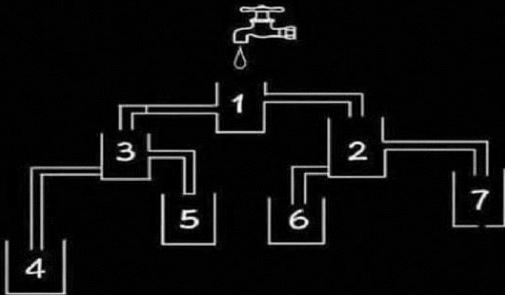

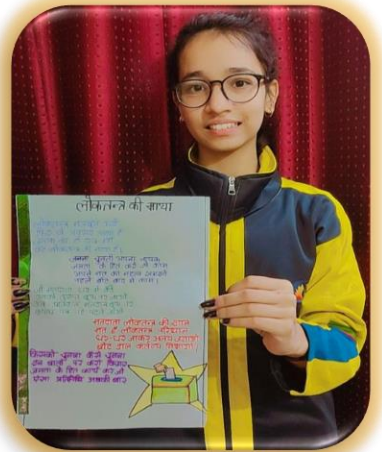

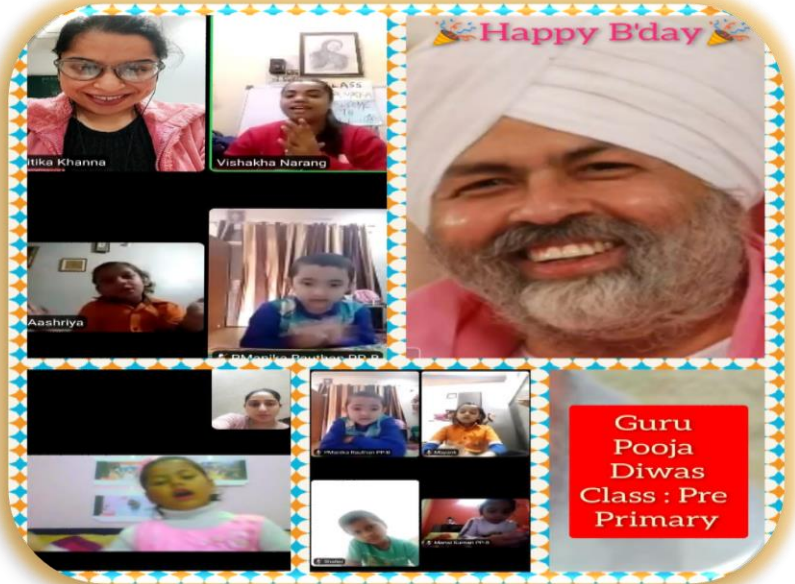
