'Cleaner water, cleaner tomorrow.'

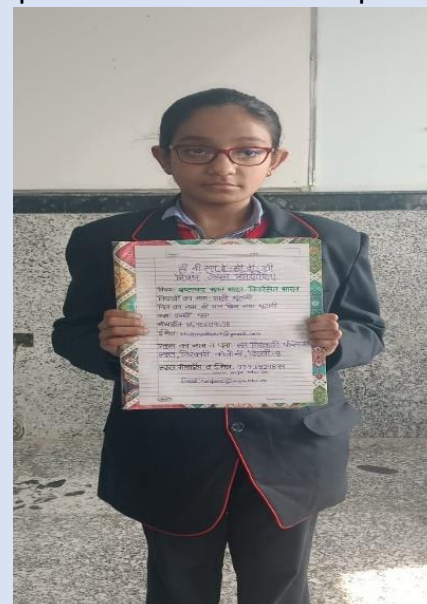

The students were served with delicious lunch at the right interval and the funtabulous day ended with joy and excitement.



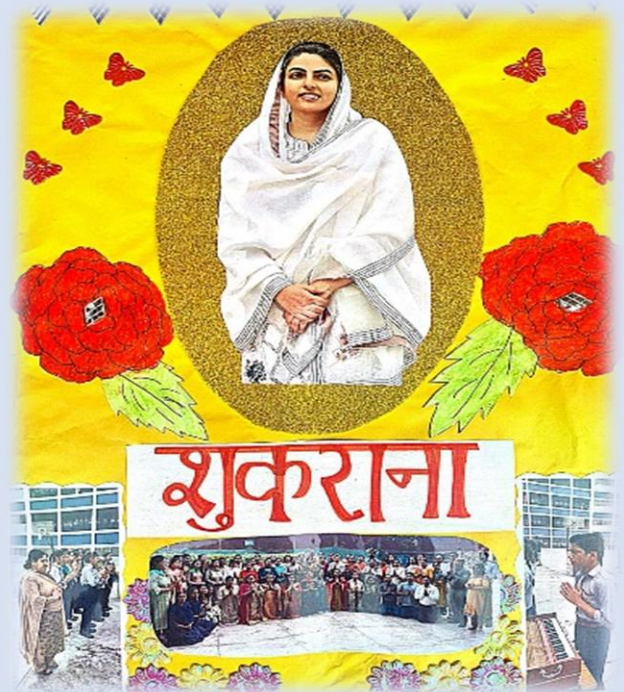
75TH NIRANKARI SANT SAMAGAM CELEBRATION (15.11.2022)

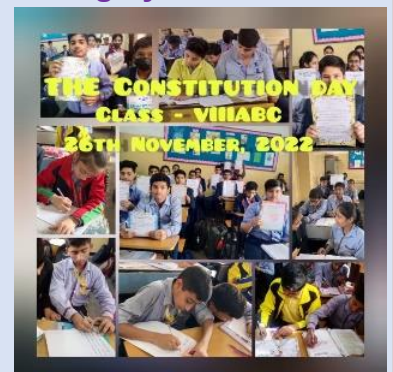
PARTICIPATION IN PROJECT VEER GATHA 2.0 (20.11.22)

CONSTITUTION DAY (26.11.22)

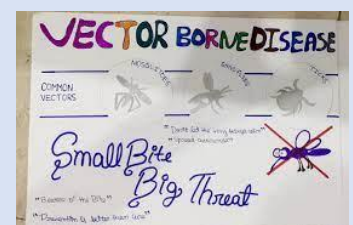
“The right way of celebrating Indian Constitution Day is - abiding by it.”

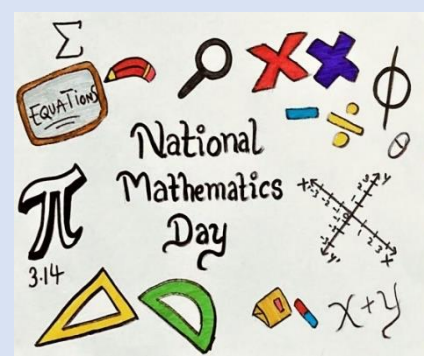


NATIONAL MATHEMATICS DAY (22.12.22)

PICNIC (11.11.22)

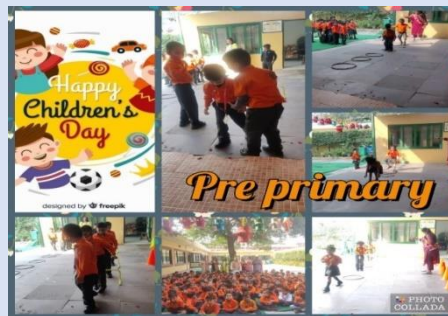

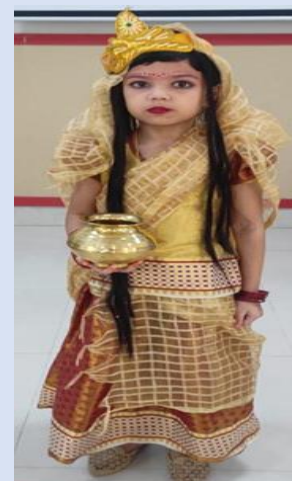


INTRA CLASS FANCY DRESS COMPETITION ON FAVOURITE FESTIVAL (17.10.22)

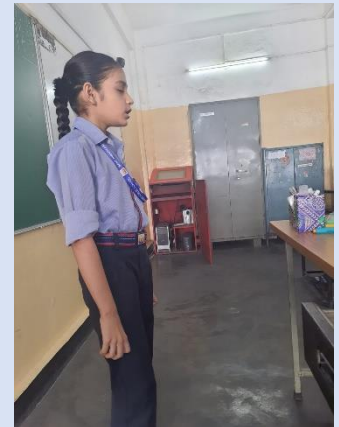

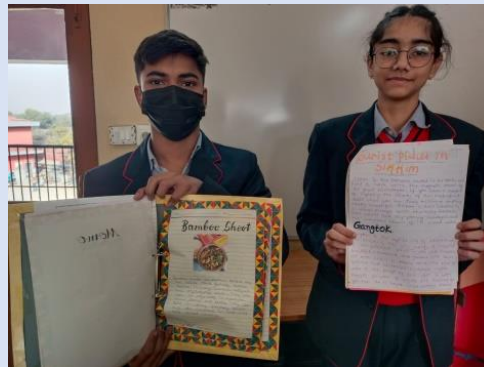

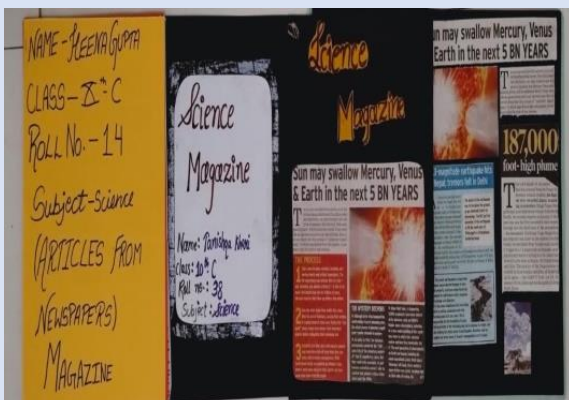

In order to imbue sensitivity in society and remove prejudices against girl child, a Poster Making Competition on gender equity and empowerment of girls was

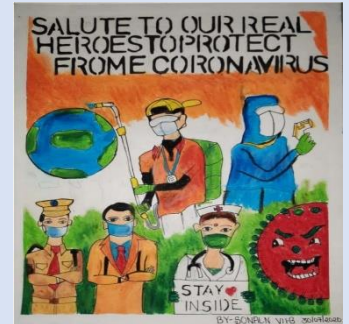


organized for the students of grades IX & X. The students brought out their creative expressions and artistic skills through an array of posters, on the topics of Women Empowerment and Girl Education.

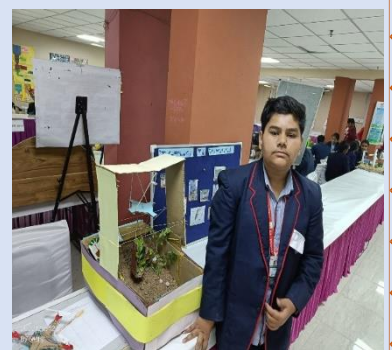
