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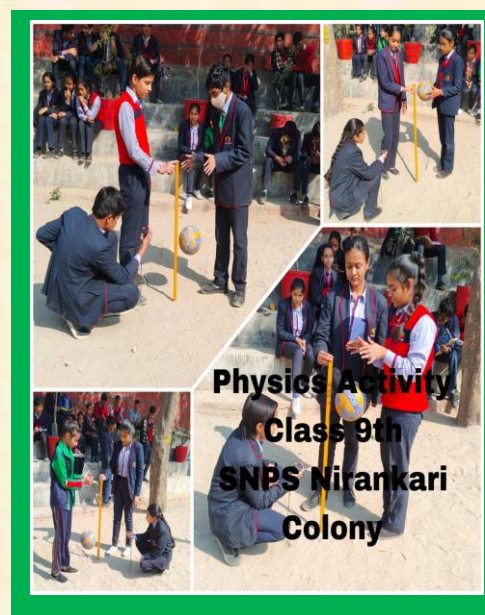
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CBSE AND OTHER CELEBRATIONS

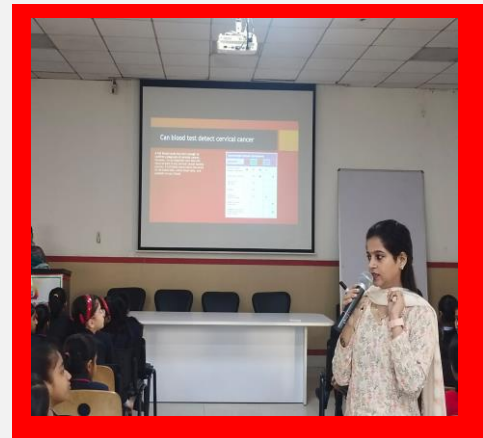


CYBER AWARENESS CAMPAIGN (08.02.23)

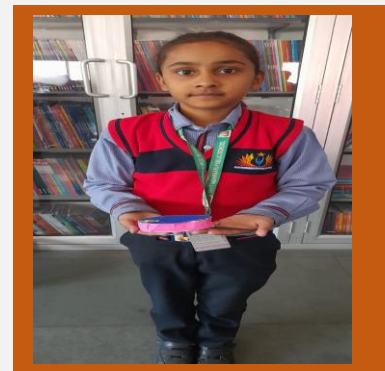

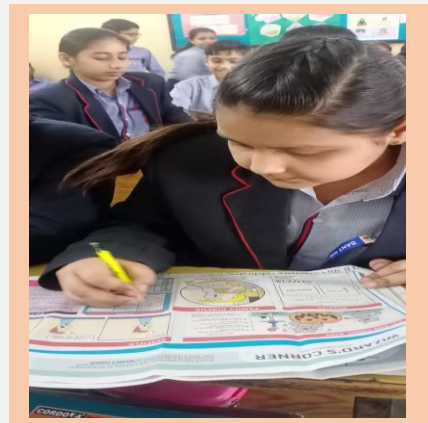

EDUCATIONAL TRIP TO NATIONAL MUSEUM-GRADE X & XII (28 & 29.03.23)

In an endeavour to promote holistic learning and knowledge of our varied cultural heritage, the school conducted a visit to the National Museum in New Delhi, one of the largest museums in India, on March 28 & 29, 2023 for classes X and XII respectively. Established in 1949, it holds variety of articles ranging from pre-historic era to modern works of art. A five-tier wooden temple chariot built in South India in the 19th century welcomes the visitors at the entry gate of the museum. The first gallery houses finds from the Harappan Civilisation. The Mauryas, the Shungas and the Satvahanas Gallery housed objects from 4th century BCE to the 1st century BCE. The gallery also houses fragments of railings from various ancient Stupas that are carved with episodes from Buddha's Life. The last gallery was the Miniature Painting Gallery, housing over 17,000 miniature paintings. The paintings show the rich heritage of Indian art through the centuries.

All in all, the visit was a fruitful one as the students got an opportunity to visualise the knowledge they gained from books and understand the importance of our historical civilisations and their culture. parts of which we have imbibed even in our present cultures.
