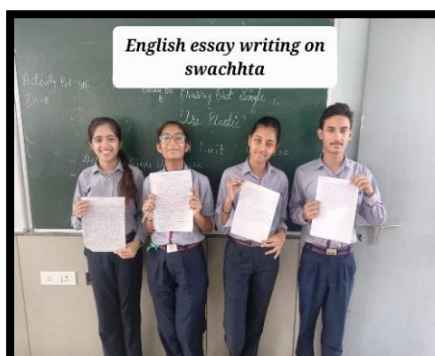

SWACHHATA HI SEVA CAMPAIGN –Gandhi Jayanti (02.10.23- 31.10.23)

A SIMPLE STEP TOWARDS BECOMING GREENER AND LESS WASTEFUL

Swachhata Hi Seva Campaign 2023, launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, to commemorate the birth anniversary of the Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi, aims to reinforce 'sanitation as everyone's business' and is focussed on plastic waste management as its key theme. It seeks to intensify the momentum by encouraging the masses to undertake "Shramdaan " for Swachhata. Under this big umbrella, the school took a number of activities extensively. Green Pledge was administered in the school assembly and the interactors mobilized students to undertake "Shramdaan" by collecting waste from and around the school campus. They also took up an awareness campaign to limit the use of single-use plastic. Lending further impetus towards a cleaner India, the school also appealed to the students and stakeholders to dedicate "One hour of Shramdaan for Swachhata" towards 'Swachhata Hi Seva' initiative.

The E-pledge campaign aimed at promoting 'a drug-free environment' in schools. In lieu of the same, the school adopted an online outreach to reach a broader audience. Engaging content – including PPTs, infographics, and testimonials were created to convey the message. In addition, dissemination of content from the online government portal in morning assemblies, and regular sessions in classes provided students with valuable information about the risks associated with drug use and ways to make informed decisions.

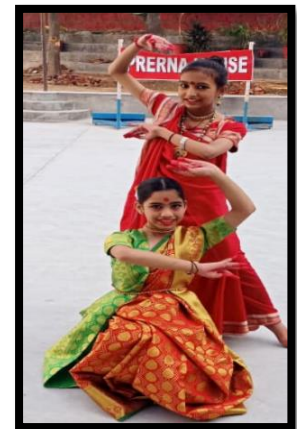

(1.12.23 & 2.12.23)

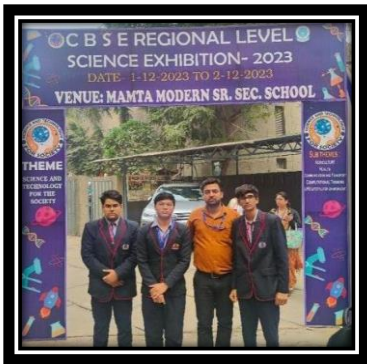

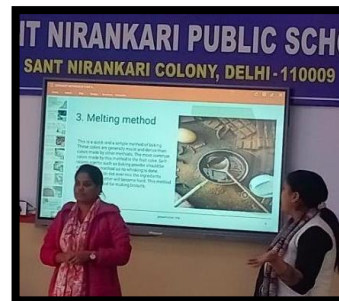
SKILL MODULE COURSE (BAKERY), SESSION-I (27.10.23)

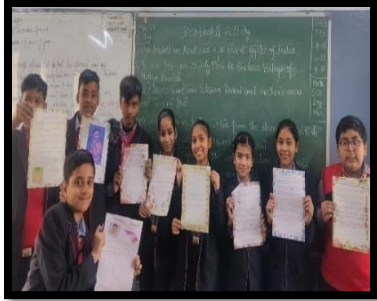

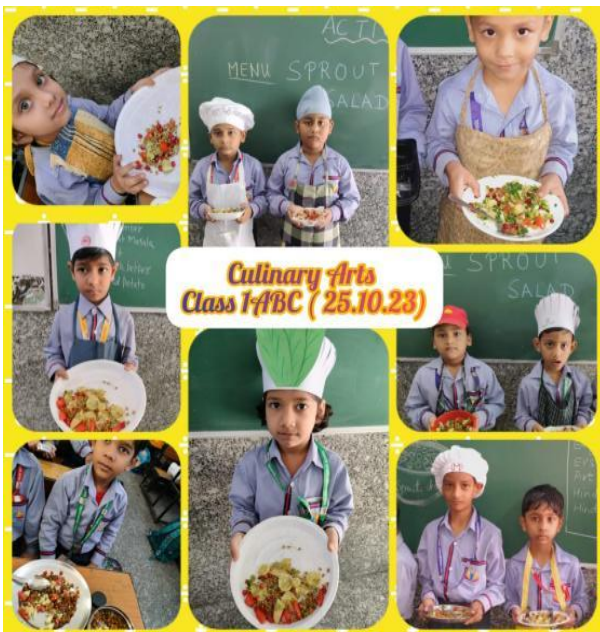

MATHS ONFIELD (27-12-23)

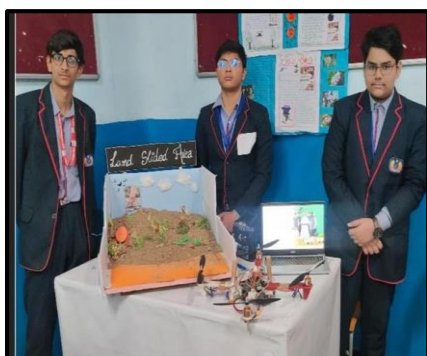
